

CBAA Juried Show Protocol

The Juried Show Program at the Cannon Beach Gallery is one of the unique programs that the CBAA offers for both local and regional artists, emerging and professional.

At least four times a year, an open call for work goes out to artists requesting submissions for our juried shows.

Sometimes these shows have themes, but not always.

Criteria

All artwork needs to be an original piece (not a reproduction).

Photography: we do accept traditional and digital photography, which has its own criteria due to its inherent nature (i.e., giclee prints are okay for photography).

Three dimensional works of art are both accepted and encouraged.

All artwork needs to have been completed within the past two years outside of school.

All artwork needs to be exhibition ready, which means that it needs to be easy for the Gallery Committee to hang with a securely attached wire on the back. Artwork which is not exhibition ready will not be considered for hanging.

All artwork needs to be for sale, the gallery takes a 40% commission.

Procedures

Original artwork should be brought into the Cannon Beach Gallery (1064 S. Hemlock St.) between 10-4 PM on the submission date, which is usually the first Thursday of the month.

All proper paperwork needs to be filled out, with the juried form completed and each piece identified on the back with title, artist name, medium and retail price.

A consignment agreement is also required.

Both forms are available on the website or at the Cannon Beach Gallery.

Any artwork that is not accepted needs to be retrieved within one week of the drop off date. The Cannon Beach Gallery has limited storage space and requests that artists get their work as soon as possible after the jurying process.

All artists will be notified by phone whether or not their work was accepted by the juror on the evening following the drop off date, which is usually a Friday.

Application Fee

There is no longer an application fee for submitting work to the Cannon Beach Gallery.

Artists are encouraged to become members of the Cannon Beach Arts Association, which manages the Cannon Beach Gallery as one of its programs.

Members receive monthly mailings about upcoming exhibits, our biannual newsletter and a 5% discount on purchases made at the gallery. An individual membership starts at \$35.

Artist Information

Artists are encouraged to bring in a biography and artist statement with their work.
