\$3,000 INDIVIDUAL ARTIST GRANT 2009

The **Cannon Beach Arts Association** offers an Individual Artist Grant(s) for original work each year. The 2009 grant amount is \$3,000 and may be awarded in part or in total to those who qualify.*

PURPOSE

The Artist Grant(s) is intended to promote the work of local artists and to provide support necessary to expand their creative process. It is also the intent to encourage a wider art audience and quality art experiences within the community. The artist must provide a return to the community, by means of temporary exhibit, performance, community education, publication, or as otherwise specified a portion of the funded project as defined in the proposal.

WHO MAY APPLY

The Artist Grant is open to visual artists, writers, performers and musicians; showing serious intent and working to produce original material. Artists must be part of the Cannon Beach community, producing or actively exhibiting or performing within the city, or document short-term residence for the duration of the project proposed.

PROCESS

The Artist Grant(s) will be awarded on the basis of the grant proposal. The Cannon Beach Arts Association Grant Committee will review the proposals and notify applicants of their decision by mail within 30 days of the application deadline. The grant finalist(s) is subject to a final evaluation before funds are granted. The artist must commit to a project deadline and enter into a contract with the CBAA. The project must be designed to be completed and presented within 12 months from the deadline date.

EVALUATION CRITERIA

- Quality of the project as described by the applicant.
- The project is for new work or work in progress (projects already completed do not qualify).
- Community interest in and benefit from the proposal.
- History of sound professional management by the applicant.

HOW TO APPLY

- Fill out the attached Individual Artist Grant Application.
- Attach a detailed proposal that states goals, objectives, and methods of project.
- Clearly define your own monetary investment in the project. List in detail any cost of materials or aids required for the completion of the project.
- State the time frame of the project, giving definite date of completion.
- Give a history of your ability to professionally manage the project (stating previous commitments, grants, etc.)
- Summarize the project presentation (by performance, exhibit, reading, etc) and state the benefit to the Cannon Beach art audience.
- Provide a representational sample of past work in such forms as slides, digital images, photographs, audio or video recordings, or duplication appropriate to the medium of the applicant.
- Submit a typed proposal with 6 duplications.

DEADLINE

All proposals must be completed in full and submitted by **June 1, 2009**. Proposals postmarked after that date do not qualify.

* The Cannon Beach Arts Association Grant Committee reserves the right to withhold some or all of the Individual Artist Grant funds if it is deemed that none of the applicants meet the stated criteria.
